Along with activist Dennis Peron, Rathbun lobbied for the legalization of cannabis for medical use, and she helped pass San Francisco Proposition P (1991) and California Proposition 215

(1996) to achieve those goals. As a hospital volunteer at San Francisco General Hospital, she became known for baking and distributing cannabis brownies to AIDS patients 882b6fb17a

Hang Far Low was established in the 1880s and lasted decades. The Four Seas Restaurant was established soon after the \$250,000 (equivalent to \$2,721,000 in 2025) interior reconstruction in 1960. After lasting over five decades, the Four Seas Restaurant was shut down when its lease was ending in 2013. Meanwhile, a

number of restaurants in Chinatown, including ones that could hold wedding receptions, had been declining. More restaurateurs shifted to the Avenues and the South Bay, more likely middle-class areas. 882b6fb17a The restaurant is known for serving hamburgers and pies.
