Dual process theory Verbalized explicit processes or attitudes and actions may change with persuasion or education; though implicit process or attitudes usually take a long amount of time to change with the forming of new habits. Often, the two processes consist of an implicit (automatic), unconscious process and an explicit (controlled), conscious process. and similarity relations to determine reasoning rather than an underlying mechanical structure.
