== Early life ==

Northanger Abbey Although the title page is dated 1818 and the novel was published posthumously in 1817 with *Persuasion*, *Northanger Abbey* was completed in 1799. From a fondness of Gothic novels and an active imagination distorting her worldview, the story follows Catherine Morland, the naïve young protagonist, as she develops a better understanding of herself and the world around her. interest in seven Gothic titles that had largely fallen into obscurity; the "horrid novels". There are also many references to *Northanger Abbey* in contemporary *Northanger Abbey* (NOR-thang-ər), written by the English author Jane Austen, is a coming-of-age novel and a satire of Gothic novels

Inspiration also came from Cain and Abel, Oedipus Rex, Seinfeld, and Simon's own childhood, growing up in California the eldest of four siblings (including her sister Anne), desperately wanting to be an only child. They lived in small houses with confined spaces, with their father Mayo writing upstairs and telling them to be quiet. Simon also stated that she would be perfect and work hard at school, but be horrid and slam doors at home, describing herself as a "mixture of both Henry and Peter". Three more stories were written by Simon at Elliott's request to form a full book. On 17 February 2007, there was another rebrand

featuring 4 mascots; Rooftop (a moose), Beat (a mouse/rat), Colin (a brain) and Spoon (a humanlike creature), designed by Studio AKA. The new 'worldwide rebrand' logo for Nicktoons was introduced on 30 April 2010, with a new imaging campaign introduced on 11 February 2012. In 1878, at the age of 16, Ball finished fifth in The Open at Prestwick. His run of Amateur titles began in 1888 and stretched until 1912, when he was 51 years old. His best year was 1890, when he won both the Amateur and Open Championships. Bobby Jones, who won the Grand Slam in 1930, is the only other golfer in history to win those two tournaments in the same year.

The word is a loan of a French term for "butchery" or "carnage". Other terms with overlapping scope include war crime, pogrom, mass killing, mass murder, and extrajudicial killing. The use of macecre "butchery" of the mass killing of people dates to the 12th century, implying people being "slaughtered like animals".
