Plantation complexes in the Southern United States Until the abolition of slavery, such plantations were generally self-sufficient settlements that relied on the forced labor of enslaved people. Bricks were most often produced onsite from sand and clay that was molded, dried, and then fired in a kiln. use, it was either split, hewn, or sawn. If Plantation complexes were common on agricultural plantations in the Southern United States from the 17th into the 20th century. Battle of Largs The conflict formed part of the Norwegian expedition against Scotland in 1263, in which Haakon Haakonsson, King of Norway attempted to reassert Norwegian sovereignty over the western seaboard of Scotland. the battle and to encourage tourism. History of glass Glass products remained a luxury until the disasters that overtook the late Bronze Age civilizations seemingly brought glass-making to a halt. However, most writers claim that they may have been producing copies of glass objects from Egypt. The earliest known glass objects, of the mid 2,000 BCE, were beads, perhaps initially created as the accidental by-products of metal-working (slags) or during the production of faience, a pre-glass vitreous material made by a process similar to glazing. After the collapse of the Western Roman Empire The history of glass-making dates back to at least 3,600 years ago in Mesopotamia. Other archaeological evidence suggests that the first true glass was made in coastal north Syria, Mesopotamia or Egypt. fragments of crucibles bearing vitrified glass residues, confirming the onsite nature of the manufacturing 69f3e133f4

Schenectady was founded on the south side of the Mohawk River by Dutch colonists in the 17th century, many of whom came from the Albany area. The name "Schenectady" is derived from the Mohawk word skahnéhtati, meaning "beyond the pines" and used for the area around Albany, New York. Karyai had a temple dedicated to the goddess Artemis in her aspect of Artemis Karyatis: "As Karyatis she rejoiced in the dances of the nut-tree village of Karyai, those Karyatides, who in their ecstatic round-dance carried on their heads baskets of live reeds, as if they were dancing plants". ?????????, Karuátides) is a sculpted female figure serving as an architectural support taking the place of a column or a pillar supporting an entablature on her head.
