Multimethodology Another applicable, but less often used label, for multi or mixed research is methodological pluralism. Mixed methods research Multimethodology or multimethod research includes the use of more than one method of data collection or research in a research study or set of related studies. One could argue that mixed methods research is a special case of multimethod research. All of these approaches to professional and academic research emphasize that monomethod research can be improved through the use of multiple data sources, methods, research methodologies, perspectives, standpoints, and paradigms. It is particularly useful when researchers want to understand the meaning that people attach to their experiences or when they want to uncover the underlying reasons for people's behavior.
