Tracing tactile learning tendencies back to Quintilian, Séguin, and Montessori, Fernald's kinesthetic spelling and reading method prompted struggling students to trace words. The popular kinesthetic method anchors modern instruction in the areas of special education and remedial reading. By 1911 Fernald had accepted a position at UCLA. Kinesthetic learning is also included as one of Howard Gardner's multiple intelligences. Fernald established "the first clinic for remedial instruction in 1921 at the University of California, Los Angeles" d226446103
