The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine

Unlike artificial narrow intelligence (ANI), whose competence is confined to well-defined tasks, an AGI system can generalise knowledge, transfer skills between domains, and solve novel problems without task-specific reprogramming. An individual's construction of reality, not the objective input, may dictate their behavior in the world. Thus, cognitive biases may sometimes lead to perceptual distortion, inaccurate judgment, illogical interpretation, and irrationality. Individuals create their own "subjective reality" from their perception of the input. judgment and decision-making in cognitive science, social psychology, and behavioral economics a1679b8893

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
