The resulting medium then has many properties and characteristics of normal fluids, such as the ability to free-flow under gravity, or to be pumped using fluid technologies. The usual way to achieve a fluidized bed is to pump pressurized fluid into the particles 18cc6708c1

In 1794, Thomas Mead patented a gas engine. Following the first commercial steam engine (a type of external combustion engine) by Thomas Savery in 1698, various efforts were made during

the 18th century to develop equivalent internal combustion engines. In 1798, John Stevens designed the first American internal combustion engine. Also in 1794, Robert Street patented an internal-combustion engine, which was also the first to use liquid fuel (petroleum) and built an engine around that time. In 1791, the English inventor John Barber patented a gas turbine. In 1807, French engineers Nicéphore and Claude Niépce ran a prototype internal combustion engine, using controlled dust explosions, the Pyr  olophore 18cc6708c1
