ICONIX is its use of robustness analysis, a method for
bridging the gap between analysis and design.
Robustness analysis reduces the ambiguity in use case
descriptions, by ensuring that they are written in the
context of an accompanying domain model. This process
makes the use cases much easier to design, test and
estimate. df5306ea08 He is known for having spoken out
