

The Bamboo Stalk

In 2010, Saud Alsanousi made his literary debut with *The Prisoner of Mirrors*, which won the Laila al-Othman Prize, an award recognizing promising emerging writers. He gained further recognition by winning first prize for his short story *The Bonsai and the Old Man* in the 'Stories on Air' competition organized by Al-Arabi magazine and BBC Arabic in 2011. In 2012, his novel *The Bamboo Stalk* (Arabic: *Al-Sa'at al-Bamboo*) is a 2012 novel by Kuwaiti writer Saud Alsanousi, for which he won the State Prize for Literature in Kuwait in 2012, and the International Prize for Arabic Fiction (known as the Arabic Booker Prize) in 2013,, making Alsanousi the youngest Arab writer and first Kuwaiti author to receive this prestigious award
